

Currently, 76.6% of the 57,375 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 19.8%, renter occupied; and 3.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 55,218 housing units in the area - 77.5% owner occupied, 18.7% renter occupied, and 3.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.72%. Median home value in the area is \$205,433, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.73% annually to \$235,010.




Population by Age






2016 Household Income







Population by Age
