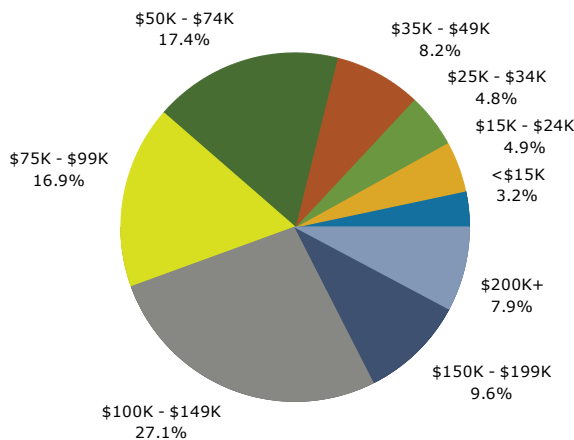

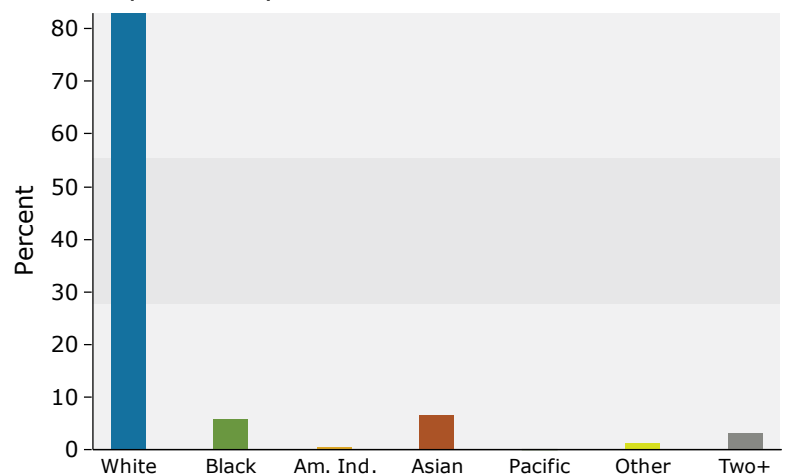
Population by Age

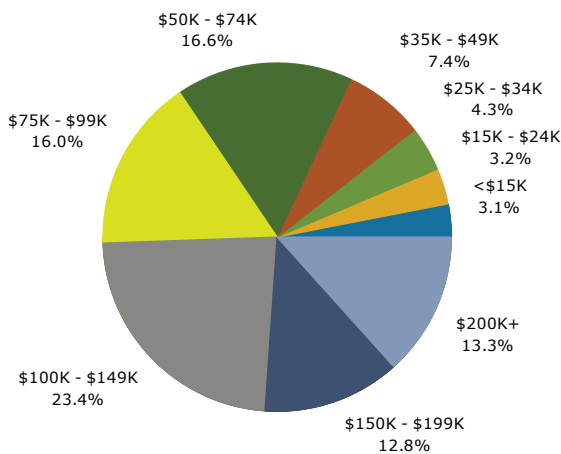

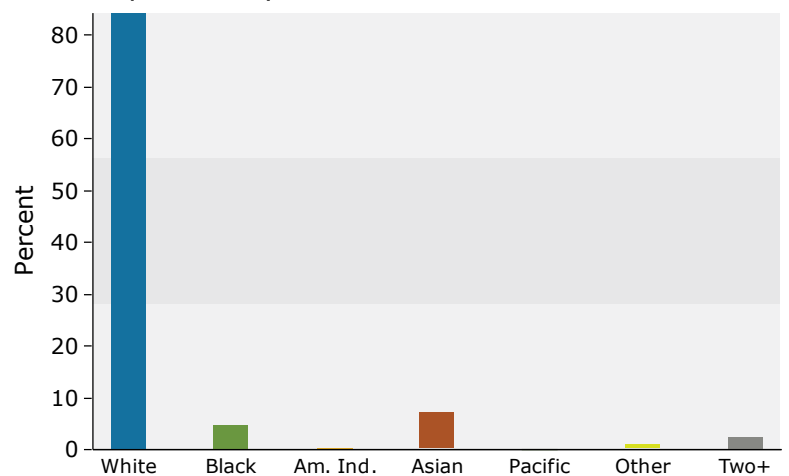
Population by Age

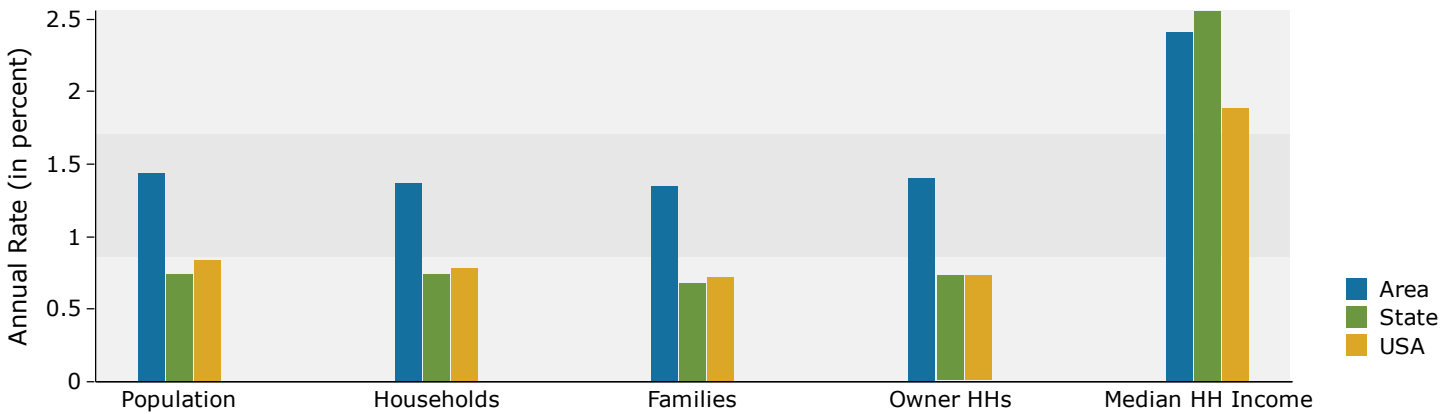

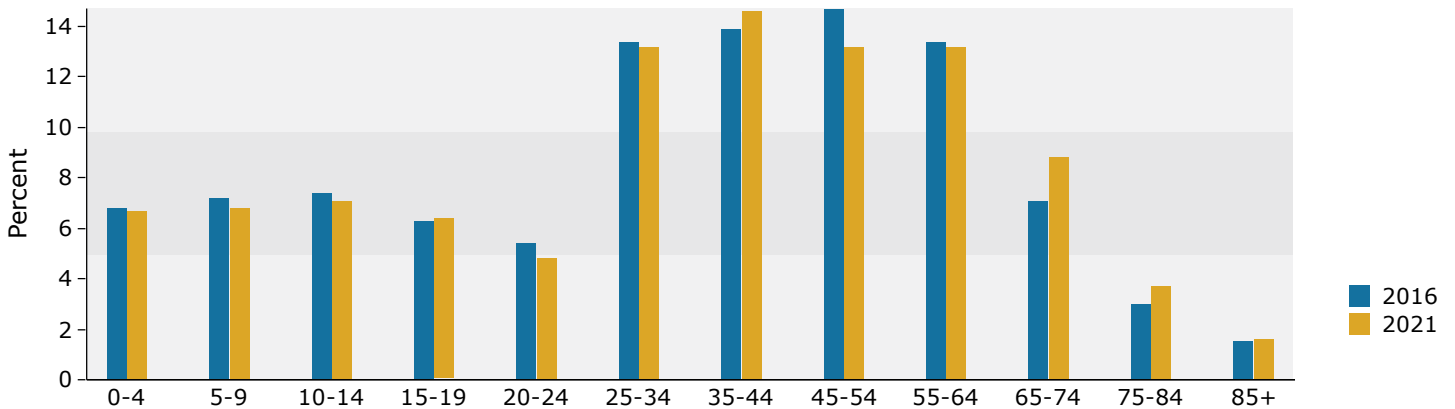

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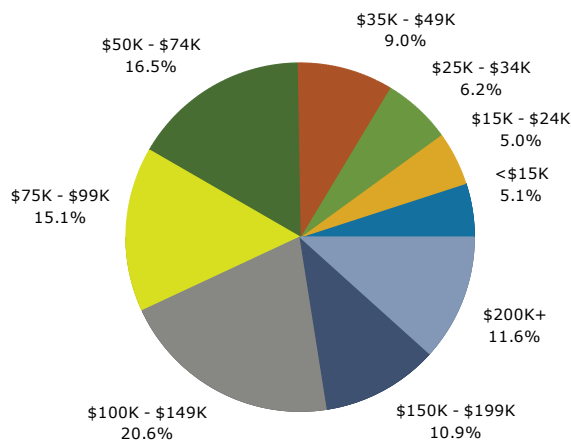
Trends 2016-2021



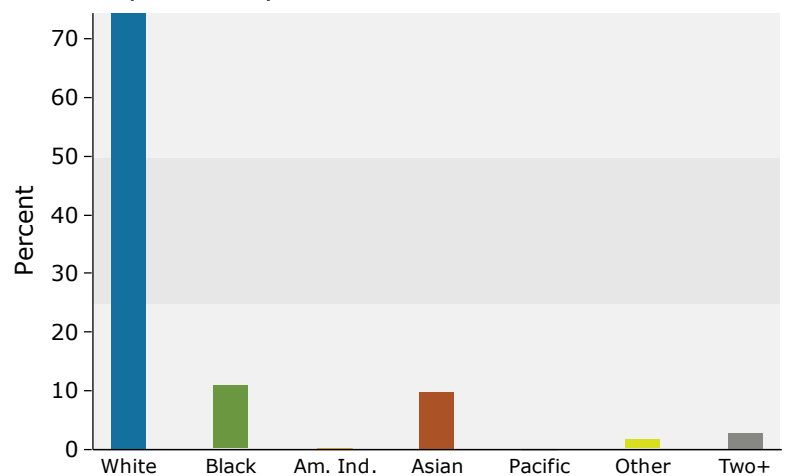
Population by Age
