

Currently, 65.3% of the 78,124 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.4%, renter occupied; and 4.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 74,811 housing units in the area - 65.9% owner occupied, 28.6% renter occupied, and 5.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.94%. Median home value in the area is \$211,671, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.14% annually to \$235,278.






#### Trends 2017-2022




### Population by Age






### Population by Age
