

The below information was taken directly from the City's website. This information is provided as a general guide to assist business owners and property owners in understanding the regulations governing temporary signage. For additional information, specific questions, and/or to obtain a temporary sign permit please contact the City of Blaine directly at 763-784-6700.

- Temporary signs are any signs which are erected or displayed for a limited period of time.
- All temporary signs require a temporary sign permit before they are installed. Please contact the City of Blaine directly or visit their website (www.ci.blaine.mn.us) for a current permit and fee schedule.
- Temporary signs may be displayed for a period not to exceed fourteen (14) consecutive days. Four (4) temporary sign permits may be allowed on each premises per calendar year, with the exception that each new commercial or industrial business may be allowed one (1) additional fourteen (14) day sign permit to announce the opening of the new business, provided such business has been issued a current Certificate of Occupancy for that business space. A calendar year is defined as the time period from January 1st - December 31st.
- Portable temporary signs shall not exceed fifty (50) square feet in size.

All temporary signs must have Landlord approval. Please contact your Property Manager directly with any questions and/or to obtain prior written approval.
