

The below information was taken directly from the City's website. This information is provided as a general guide to assist business owners and property owners in understanding the regulations governing temporary signage. •**Temporary Banner Signs:**

Temporary advertisement signs in the form of durable, weather resistant banners are allowed with a sign permit according to the requirements set forth below:

Location:

Such banners may only be attached to principal structures on a lot. No banners will be allowed in or on accessory structures, landscaped areas, motor fuel station canopies, or similar locations.

Size:

Banners must not exceed 32-square feet in size.

Time Limit for Display:

Banner may only be displayed for a cumulative total of 15-days or less per calendar year per business. In the case of multiple tenant commercial buildings, each tenant may display temporary signs for a total of 15-days per calendar year. A calendar year is defined as the time period from January 1st - December 31st.

•**Special Event Signs:**

Special event signs are permitted no longer than a 30-day period and/or shall only be permitted through the duration of the special event. Temporary signs, including portable reader board signs, banners, balloons, inflatable devices, and the like are allowed for business grand opening events, with permit, for a period not to exceed 10-days.

All temporary signs require a temporary sign permit before they are installed. Please contact the City of Cottage Grove to obtain a sign permit application and current fee schedule.

All temporary signs must have Landlord approval. Please contact your Property Manager directly with any questions and/or to obtain prior written approval.
