

The below information was taken directly from the City's website. This information is provided as a general guide to assist business owners and property owners in understanding the regulations governing temporary signage. For additional information, specific questions, and/or to obtain a temporary sign permit please contact the City of Maple Grove directly at 763-494-6000.

- Temporary signs are signs not permanently anchored to the ground or permanently affixed to a structure.
- The use of banners, pennants, and similar devices is allowed, and such devices require a valid permit. Please contact the City of Maple Grove directly for a sign permit application and fee schedule.
[Note: These devices are subject to Landlord approval prior to fabrication and/or installation.]
- Banners, pennants, and similar devices may be displayed for no more than 10-consecutive days.
- No more than 1-permit per business shall be granted during any 12-month period.
- The area of a banner, pennant, or similar device shall not exceed 40-square feet.
- Not more than 1-banner, pennant, or similar device shall be displayed upon a property at any given time.
- No signs, guys, stays, or attachments shall be erected, placed, or maintained on trees nor interfere with any electric light, power, telephone, or telegraph wires or the supports thereof.
- No sign or sign structure shall be erected or maintained that prevents free ingress or egress from any door, window, or fire escape. No sign or sign structure shall be attached to a standpipe or fire escape.
- Signs requiring permits shall display, in a conspicuous manner, the permit sticker or sticker number.
- Portable signs and like devices are expressly prohibited.

All temporary signs must have Landlord approval. Please contact your Property Manager directly with any questions and/or to obtain prior written approval.
