

The below information was taken directly from the City's website. This information is provided as a general guide to assist business owners and property owners in understanding the regulations governing temporary signage. For additional information, specific questions, and/or to obtain a temporary sign permit please contact the City of Big Lake directly at 763-263-2107.

- Temporary signs are signs erected or displayed for a specific period of time and are not permanently mounted.
- Temporary signs are permitted provided a sign permit is obtained from the City of Big Lake.
- Temporary signs shall be allowed in business and industrial zoning districts, businesses operating by a conditional use permit, and public and charitable events. There shall be no more than one (1) temporary sign in any required yard; no more than three (3) such signs on any lot, and the total area of each sign shall be displayed for no longer than twenty-one (21) consecutive days per calendar month. In no case shall temporary signs take up required off-street parking space.

All temporary signs must have Landlord approval. Please contact your Property Manager directly with any questions and/or to obtain prior written approval.
