

The below information was taken from Maple Grove's City Ordinance. This information is provided as a general guide to assist business owners and property owners in understanding the regulations governing temporary signage. For additional information, specific questions, or to obtain a temporary sign permit please contact the City of Maple Grove directly.

1. Temporary signs are signs not permanently anchored to the ground or permanently affixed to a structure.
2. The City of Maple Grove allows the use of banners, pennants, and similar devices subject to Landlord approval.
3. Banners, pennants, and similar devices may be displayed for no more than ten (10) consecutive days.
4. No more than one (1) permit per business shall be granted during any twelve (12) month period.
5. The area of a banner, pennant, or similar device shall not exceed forty (40) square feet.
6. Not more than one (1) banner, pennant, or similar device shall be displayed upon a property at any given time.
7. No signs, guys, stays, or attachments shall be erected, placed, or maintained on trees nor interfere with any electric light, power, telephone, or telegraph wires or the supports thereof.
8. No sign or sign structure shall be erected or maintained that prevents free ingress or egress from any door, window, or fire escape. No sign or sign structure shall be attached to a standpipe or fire escape.
9. Signs requiring permits shall display, in a conspicuous manner, the permit sticker or sticker number.
10. Portable signs and like devices are expressly prohibited.

As a reminder, a permit is required for all temporary signs. Please contact the City of Maple Grove directly for a permit application and fee schedule.

All temporary signs must have Landlord approval. Please contact your Property Manager directly with questions and/or to obtain written approval.
