

The below information was taken directly from the City's website. This information is provided as a general guide to assist business owners and property owners in understanding the regulations governing temporary signage. For additional information, specific questions, and/or to obtain a temporary sign permit please contact the City of Brooklyn Park directly at 763-493-8070.

- Temporary signs are signs not permanently anchored to the ground or permanently affixed to a structure.
- There shall be no more than one (1) temporary sign per business at any one (1) time.
- Temporary signs cannot exceed twelve (12) square feet in size.
- Each business is allowed a maximum of three (3) permits in one (1) calendar year for a banner. Each permit is good for one (1) calendar month. For example, if a sale is from July 20th - August 20th, two (2) separate permits are required, one for July and one for August.
- Banners are allowed to be displayed on existing fences, accessory buildings and principle building facades provided they meet the fifteen (15) foot setback requirements. The total area of all signs in the form of banners may not exceed two-hundred (200) square feet.
- The following types of temporary signs are allowed by City ordinances:
 - Banners
 - Non-profit event sign
 - Real estate signs
 - Searchlights
 - Farmer's market signs
 - Garage sale signs
 - Window signs
 - Construction signs
 - Temporary campaign signs

All temporary signs must have Landlord approval. Please contact your Property Manager directly with any questions and/or to obtain prior written approval.
